- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. “Now since the LORD has kept you, my master, from bloodshed and from avenging yourself with your own hands, as surely as the LORD lives and as you live, may your enemies and all who intend to harm my master be like Nabal.”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. “Not so, my lord,” Hannah replied, “I am a woman who is deeply troubled. I have not been drinking wine or beer; I was pouring out my soul to the LORD.”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. “Who can stand in the presence of the LORD, this holy God? To whom will the ark go up from here?”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. “When I saw that the men were scattering, and that you did not come at the set time, and that the Philistines were assembling at Micmash,”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. The LORD called Samuel a third time, and Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, “Here I am; you called me.”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. The next day an evil spirit from God came forcefully upon Saul. He was prophesying in his house, while David was playing the harp, as he usually did.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. Then Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. But the prophet Gad said to David, “Do not stay in the stronghold. Go into the land of Judah.” So David left and went to the forest of Hereth.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10. The ark of God was captured, and Eli's two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, died.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 11. Goliath stood and shouted to the ranks of Israel, “Why do you come out and line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and are you not the servants of Saul? Choose a man and have him come down to me.”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12. With these words David rebuked his men and did not allow them to attack Saul. And Saul left the cave and went his way.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 13. Then Saul attacked the Amalekites all the way from Havilah to Shur, to the east of Egypt.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 14. The name of his firstborn was Joel and the name of his second was Abijah, and they served at Beersheba.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 15. “And what happens to your two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, will be a sign to you—they will both die on the same day.”
- \_\_\_\_\_ 16. “Look, in this town there is a man of God; he is highly respected, and everything he says comes true. Let's go there now. Perhaps he will tell us what way to take.”

- \_\_\_\_\_17. “God has handed him over to me, for David has imprisoned himself by entering a town with gates and bars.”
- \_\_\_\_\_18. “But they forgot the LORD their God; so he sold them into the hand of Sisera, the commander of the army of Hazor, and into the hands of the Philistines and the king of Moab, who fought against them.”
- \_\_\_\_\_19. So they sent the ark of God to Ekron. As the ark of God was entering Ekron, the people of Ekron cried out, “They have brought the ark of the god of Israel around to us to kill us and our people.”
- \_\_\_\_\_20. As you approach the town, you will meet a procession of prophets coming down from the high place with lyres, tambourines, flutes and harps being played before them, and they will be prophesying.
